

Quick Guide: How do I disable pop-ups in web browsers?



Part I –

By default, Internet Explorer displays pop-ups that appear as a result of clicking a link or button. Pop-up Blocker blocks pop-ups that are displayed automatically. To allow a specific web site to display NOA automatic pop-ups, please follow below instructions.

Part II- Internet Explorer



1. At the upper right, click the Tools icon, and select Internet options;
2. Click the privacy tab;
3. Check/Uncheck Turn on Pop-up Blocker and click on “Ok” to confirm the change.

Note: To access advanced features, in the “Pop-up Blocker” section, clicking settings...




Part III – Google Chrome

1. At the upper right, click the wrench icon, and select Settings;
2. Click Under the Hood;
3. In the “Privacy and Security” section, click on “content settings” which is under “Advanced”;
4. In the “Popups” section, select “Allowed” to allow all sites to show pop-ups.



Part III – Safari on your iphone

1. Open Settings;
2. Scroll down to Safari and tap it;
3. Toggle off Block Pop-ups – A grey toggle indicates a disabled pop-up blocker.
